Issue: The laboratory received one broken amber bottle each for samples COCE9, COCF1, COCG3 and COCQ1, and two broken amber bottles for sample COCP1. The remaining sample containers were received in good condition. There is no evidence of cross contamination and there is sufficient volume to proceed with the analysis, but not enough volume to analyze any possible re-extractions/ reanalyses.

Please note that the laboratory may contact the appropriate CLP PM should any defects need to be waived for this issue.


