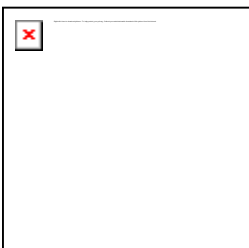

The remaining sample containers were received in good condition. There is no evidence of cross contamination and there is sufficient volume to proceed with the analysis, but not enough volume to analyze any possible re-extractions/ reanalyses.
