B. Parameters

According to the Chain of Custody document, the following analyses were requested: VOC-TCLVOA-10. This data package contains results for VOC-TCLVOA-10.

C. Analytical Techniques:

The analysis performed on instrument MSVOA_X were done using GC column DB-624UI 20m 0.18mm 1.0 um. Cat#121-1324UI. The analysis of VOC-TCLVOA-10 was based on method 8260D.

D. QA/ QC Samples:

The Holding Times were met for all analysis.

The Surrogate recoveries were met for all analysis.

The Internal Standards Areas were met for all analysis.

The Retention Times were met for all analysis.

The MS {Q3248-09MS} with File ID: VX048005.D recoveries met the requirements for all compounds except for 1,2,4-Trichlorobenzene[68%], 1,2-Dichlorobenzene[75%], 1,3-Dichlorobenzene[73%] and 1,4-Dichlorobenzene[73%] due to matrix interference.

The MSD recoveries met the requirements for all compounds.

The sample # BP-VPB-184-GW-685-687MS is failing for 1,2,4-Trichlorobenzene, 1,2-Dichlorobenzene, 1,3-Dichlorobenzene and 1,4-Dichlorobenzene therefore the original sample(BP-VPB-184-GW-685-687) is reported with M flag for this compounds.

The RPD for {Q3248-10MSD} with File ID: VX048006.D met criteria except for 1,1,2,2-Tetrachloroethane[29%], 1,2,3-Trichlorobenzene[32%], 1,2,4-Trichlorobenzene[31%], 1,2-Dibromo-3-Chloropropane[31%], 1,2-Dibromoethane[23%], 1,2-Dichlorobenzene[31%], 1,3-Dichlorobenzene[32%], 1,4-Dichlorobenzene[30%], Bromodichloromethane[21%], Bromoform[28%], Chlorobenzene[26%], cis-1,3-Dichloropropene[21%], Ethyl Benzene[26%], Isopropylbenzene[30%], m/p-Xylenes[30%], o-Xylene[27%], Styrene[27%], t-1,3-Dichloropropene[22%], Tetrachloroethene[24%] and Toluene[21%] due to difference in results of MS and MSD.

The Blank Spike met requirements for all compounds.

C. Analytical Techniques:

The samples were analyzed on instrument BNA_N using GC Column ZB-SemiVolatiles Guardian which is 30 meters, 0.25 mm ID, 0.5 um df, Catalog # 7HG-G027-17-GGA. The analysis of SVOC-SIMGroup1 was based on method 8270-Modified and extraction was done based on method 3510.

D. QA/ QC Samples:

The Holding Times were met for all analysis.

The Surrogate recoveries were met for all analysis except for,

BP-VPB-184-GW-600-602 [Terphenyl-d14 - 189%],
