A. Number of Samples and Date of Receipt:

20 Solid samples were received on 08/28/2020.

B. Parameters

According to the Chain of Custody document, the following analyses were requested: Corrosivity, Cyanide, Herbicide, Ignitability, Mercury, Metals ICP-TAL, METALS TAL+CN, PCB, Pesticide-TCL, RCRA CHARACTERISTICS, Reactive Cyanide, Reactive Sulfide, SVOC-TCL BNA -20, TCLP BNA, TCLP Extraction, TCLP Herbicide, TCLP ICP Metals, TCLP Mercury, TCLP METALS and TCLP Pesticide. This data package contains results for Herbicide.

C. Analytical Techniques:

The analysis was performed on instrument ECD_S. The front column is RTX-CLPesticides which is 30 meters, 0.32 mm ID, 0. 5 um df,: Catalog # 11139. The rear column is RTX-CLPesticides2 which is 30 meters, 0.32 mm ID, 0.25 um df, Catalog #: 11324The analysis of Herbicides was based on method 8151A and extraction was done based on method 3541.

D. QA/ QC Samples:

The Holding Times were met for all analysis. The Surrogate recoveries met the acceptable criteria.

The Retention Times were acceptable for all samples.

The MS {L3837-14MS} with File ID: PS012011.D recoveries met the requirements for all compounds except for DICAMBA[26%] due to sample matrix interference.

The MS {L3876-13MS} with File ID: PS012132.D recoveries met the requirements for all compounds except for DICAMBA[26%] due to sample matrix interference.

The MSD {L3837-15MSD} with File ID: PS012012.D recoveries met the acceptable requirements except for DICAMBA[33%] due to sample matrix interference.

The MSD {L3876-13MSD} with File ID: PS012133.D recoveries met the acceptable requirements except for DICAMBA[26%] due to sample matrix interference.

The RPD for {L3837-15MSD} with File ID: PS012012.D met criteria except for 2,4,5-T[31%], 2,4,5-TP(Silvex)[28%], 2,4-D[25%], 2,4-DB[21%] and DICAMBA[24%].



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The Blank Spike met requirements for all samples.

The Blank analysis did not indicate the presence of lab contamination.

The Initial Calibration met the requirements.

The Continuous Calibration met the requirements.

E. Additional Comments:

The soil samples results are based on a dry weight basis.
