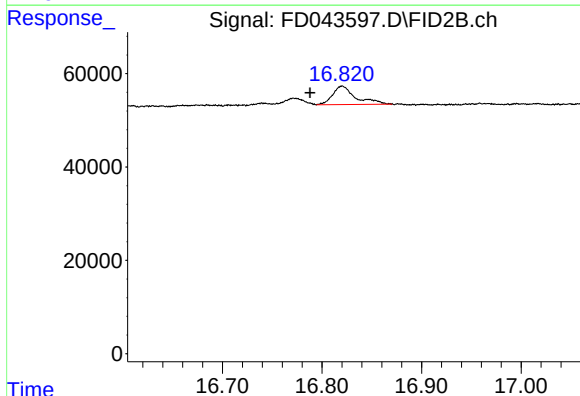
#9 ortho-Terphenyl (SURR)

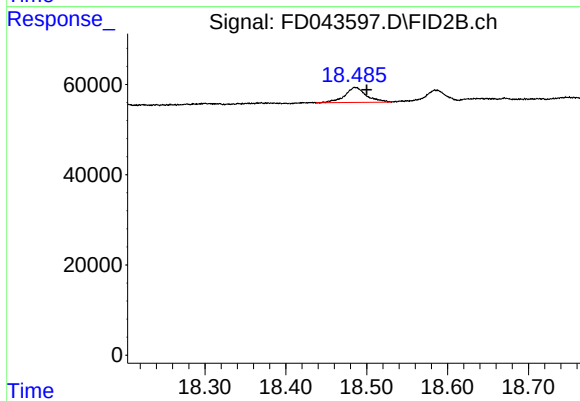
#12 1-chlorooctadecane (SURR)
